School buses will not operate, except the bus to the ferry piers of the outlying islands. (Where parents have given consent, children will travel on the bus to the ferry piers accompanied by staff living on the islands.)
Amber H Amber Rainstorm Warning	All schools will operate as normal. Please listen to radio and TV announcements in case the weather deteriorates.
	1. Perform the start of school. All schools will close all day.



Red or Black Rainstorm Warning

- 1. Before the start of school All schools will close all day.
- 2. After students have set off for school but before the commencement of schools—If students arrive at school they will be supervised until it is safe for them to be collected.

 3. When classes are in sessions—Schools continue until the end.
- 3. When classes are in sessions Schools continue until the end of normal school hours and students are retained until conditions are safe for them to return home. School buses will be cancelled if the rainstorm warning is in effect at 2:00 pm.

Criteria:

• What to use?

A3 sized paper (you can pick up A3 drawing quality paper from Mr Roscoe Rm. 232. (Please don't use low quality photocopy paper for your piece.)

You can also use art canvas/ canvas-board of varying sizes or A2 paper (at your own expense) if you prefer.

You can choose your preferred media to use. Eg. Drawing, pastels, charcoal, painting, printing, collage, photography, mixed-media etc.

• What to do?

THINK: Think about all the different ways of expressing the theme 'Light Up in the Dark' to an audience.

PLAN: Brainstorm some ideas of your images beforehand and make sketches of how you can best show them.

SELECT: Choose your **best** idea to work on using a media and the skills and techniques that you are most confident with. Think about the best use of space of your paper/ composition etc. **ACHIEVE**: take your time, work on it carefully/skillfully –achieve your best!

SUBMIT: keep your work flat and safe, submit it on time or before the deadline, clearly write your full name, class and title of your work on the back.

Selection:

Only the best **20** art pieces from Y3-Y6 will be selected for the actual exhibition.

We'll be looking for creativity, a good use of skills and techniques as well as original and interesting ideas for the **theme: 'Light Up in the Dark'**.

The art piece needs to be completed individually. Parents and friends can give help with suggesting ideas but the artwork must be completed by the children themselves.

Closing: All Kennedy artwork will be returned to school and handed back to children



Kennedy Summer Swimming Programme

To be prepared for swimming every child requires:

Kennedy School swimming kit - swimming costume or shorts/jammers.

Large white t-shirt or a swim robe

Waterproof shoes, crocs or sandals for walking to and from the pool.

Large towel, preferably a beach towel.

A strong waterproof bag.

Swimming goggles are also highly recommended. Please ensure goggles are measured to fit your child prior to their lesson to avoid your child losing pool time.


Upcycling - Laos Rugby Federation
