Please only see your child's music teacher if you particularly wish to discuss your child's progress. Also, please note that music teacher bookings are not available for the parents of Year 1 children as they have only just begun their musical journey!

PE - Mr Luck and Mrs Khemlyani will be available on a walk-in basis for 10 minute appointments on both days between 3:30pm to 6:30pm and again, Year 1 parents do not need to come to these.

Individual Needs - the IN team will see parents on an invitation-only basis with invitations being sent out by email.

Chinese - the Chinese teachers will see parents on alternative days throughout the year.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR APPOINTMENT:

- The Gateway booking system will be available from 12noon on Friday, 23 September.
- Visit <u>https://ks.tg.esf.edu.hk</u> to login to Gateway using your family login ID and password.
- On the right hand side of the Gateway homepage, click on "Click to book or update" under "Parent Consultation":

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- On the following page you will find your child's name under 'Student'.
- Under 'Event' select the class or, optionally, the Music teacher. The PE teachers are only available on a walk-in basis and the IN team by invitation only. For Year 5 and 6 music, please make sure you select the event that corresponds to your child's class.
- Under 'Date' you will be able to choose 4 or 6 October.
- The name of the teacher who teaches your child will appear next to the time slots.
- Available time slots will be shown in white colour.
- Click on the time slot you wish to book. The box will turn to pink colour and your booking will appear in the 'All confirmed bookings' box on the top right. This means that your appointment is confirmed. (This will be a 10 minute session)
- You can cancel your booking by clicking again on the slot that you have booked.

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If you have forgotten your Gateway Login ID or Password, please click on the 'forgot password or login name?' button and follow the instructions. If you experience any difficulty, please send an email to <u>itsupport@kennedy.edu.hk</u> specifying your name and your child's name & class and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

Please note we are unable to accept any telephone bookings and that if you are unable to attend any of the scheduled times, it will be difficult to reschedule.

Please note that there will be NO AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES on both 4 and 6 October.

Professional photographs of all classes and individual head-shots of all children will be taken at the school the week of 3rd to 7th October.





Kennedy School Swim Safety Week

From Thursday 29th September the children will be receiving a practical lesson on water safety. If your child has two swimming classes during the week beginning Monday 3rd October the first lesson will have the Swim Safety focus.

The Swim Safety Week is a big safety component to our swimming programme and where we introduce the students to how it feels to be fully clothed when swimming. The children will also experience basic life saving techniques should they fall into a body of water. During Water Safety Week students will learn to carry out reach rescues and rope throwing, plus safe entries and treading water - don't miss out on learning these invaluable skills next week.

The programme is designed to allow the students to experience how their swimming ability may change when in water with heavier clothes on. For the students to experience the change in the way they float, how much more tired they become, and survival techniques to use IF they were to be in water fully clothed, such as falling off a boat, being caught in a flash flood, accidentally falling into a pool etc.

The students need to bring in the following clothes IN ADDITION to their usual swim kit:

Y2: white t-shirt Y3&4: light coloured baggy shorts and white long sleeved T-shirt Y5&6: light coloured tracksuit/pyjama bottoms and white long sleeved T-shirt. Only white or light coloured clothing will be permitted in the pool as dark colours and print reacts with the chlorine.

Following our information about the use of wet suits and rash tops in the cooler weather, please ensure that your child has a good sized towel to wrap themselves up in after swimming.


